Getting Started with Your Retriever is a "Train-The-Trainer" class that's limited to 15 retrievers and their owners. This class is designed for puppies and young retrievers.

- Learn basic obedience techniques
- Introduce your dog to marking, birds and water
- Introduce your dog to gunfire at a distance

This class will meet on 8 consecutive Tuesdays, starting May 7, 2019, at 6:30pm, at the North Dakota Retriever Club training grounds located at 8335 Highway 10, Glyndon MN, 56547.

Basic Retriever Training

is for retrievers that have the "desire to retrieve" and are 6 months and older (under 6 months can join with prior approval). This is a "Train-The-Trainer" class limited to 15 retrievers and their owners.

This class will cover the following objectives:

- Improve basic obedience and command response
- Enhance retrieving desire and mouth habits
- Learn the proper use of training equipment
- Introduction to birds, gunfire and water
- Marking the fall and single retrieves on land and water

This class will meet on 8 consecutive Thursdays beginning May 2nd, at 6:00 PM, at the North Dakota Retriever Club training grounds located at 8335 Highway 10 Glyndon, MN. 56547.

The cost is \$75 per retriever/owner and you'll have access to the North Dakota Retriever Club training grounds only during your Thursday evening training sessions. You have the option to purchase a separate \$50 North Dakota Retriever Club Membership which requires a two-day volunteer obligation and provides full use of the training grounds.
