

Bird Pen Policy

The NDRC maintains six bird pens for use by club members. Members have the privilege of using these pens must agree to abide by the following policy regarding the use of the bird pens located on the main club grounds.

1. One club member is annually designated to be in charge of coordinating the bird pens. The Board defers decisions on bird pens to this club member.
2. Pens are available on a first come first serve basis to any full member in good standing.
3. Members who reserve a bird pen will supply their own lock and give the bird pen coordinator a key or combination to their lock.
4. Since limited pens are available, the bird pen coordinator may designate members to share pens.
5. The name and phone number of each person reserving pens must be displayed on the gate.
6. Pens are to be used from May 1st through September 30th each year.
7. Only legal birds to be used for training are allowed in NDRC pens.
8. Pens must be kept clean and in good order. Minor maintenance and repairs are the responsibility of the pen holder.
9. All birds must be well cared for. Birds must have food and water as well as any other needs met at all times.
10. Dead and injured birds must be removed and properly disposed of.
11. NDRC reserves the right to enter any pen for the safety of birds, recovery of escaped birds, and maintenance of the pen.
12. All expenses and time needed to correct any continuing problems in the pens will be charged to the penholder at a rate of \$50 per hour.
