



North Dakota Retriever Club Code of Conduct

- 1. Be respectful and courteous of individuals and groups training.**
- 2. After a training session, clean area of birds, shot casings, and litter.**
- 3. Return all club equipment to its proper location. Damaged equipment shall be repaired and/or reported to a board member.**
- 4. Dispose of birds properly. DO NOT PUT DEAD BIRDS IN DUMPSTER.**
- 5. If a hazard is found while training, mark the location, and report hazard to a board member.**
- 6. When exiting buildings, close all doors and turn off lights.**
- 7. During wet conditions, be cautious where you drive and stay on designated roads. DO NOT enter blocked roads.**
- 8. Keep area around live bird pens clean and keep all live birds in designated pens. When season is completed, clean bird pens.**
- 9. Dogs are our hunting partners and should be treated respectfully. Abuse of dogs on NDRC property may result in termination of membership and report to AKC.**
- 10. Enjoy our training facility and all its amenities.**
